Muzie

Muzie is a platform developed from the ground up for music lessons. It is dependable. Customer support is responsive if problems or questions arise.

Requirements:

The base requirements are a browser and a decent internet connection. Muzie works on all major platforms from Windows to Mac, IOS to Android. The better the internet connection, the bigger the screen, the faster the processor, the better the speakers etc., the better the audio/video quality during the lesson will be.

To enroll as my student:

- 1) Go to http://www.muzie.studio/signup in a web browser.
- 2) Sign up as a student. You will choose your own username and password. When prompted to enter the instructor code, enter "LEARN" in all caps. This will let Muzie know that I am your teacher.
- 3) After completing the sign-up process, you will be taken directly to your "practice room". You are encouraged to look around and become familiar.

To start our lesson:

Log in a minute or so before lesson time. You will be taken to your "practice room". As of March of 2022, you will see "Please wait for a lesson invite to appear" in the upper left. I will "invite" you at the beginning time of your lesson. You will then see a green "phone" graphic and "Please press the phone button to start. Click on it and we will get started. The window may shrink a little as the Muzie platform borrows bandwidth normally devoted to video and redirects it to the audio channel for improved sound quality. NOTE: if I will be more than five minutes late I will reach out and let you know by text. If the above instructions are not exact, the software has been updated. The exact steps should be similar.

Become Familiar:

Log in and look around the practice room for a few minutes to get familiar. Muzie has some generic features that you may find interesting. As applicable, I will populate your account with materials after your account is established. I am not able to post content for you until your account is established.
